



- Print on card stock.
- Reinforce the clock hands with either clear contact paper or clear wide tape.
- At least reinforce the back of the clock where the hole will be with wide clear tape. You can, if you wish, reinforce the whole clock face with clear contact paper.
- Cut along the gray dotted lines.
- The 'wings' on the clock are handles.
- Hold the clock up to the light to find the center point. With scissors, poke a hole in the clock, from the back. Twist the scissors to round the hole. This hole need only be big enough for the prongs of the Round-Head-Fasteners (1/8th of an inch). Let the paper from the hole to stick up in the front. This will help keep the hands in place.
- You can use a regular hole cutter to cut the hole in the clock hands.
- Put the minute hand, then the hour hand, on the clock, fasten with a Round-Head-Fastener.
